Aside from cataracts, glaucoma is the leading cause of blindness among African Americans, making African Americans 15 times more likely to be visually impaired by glaucoma than Caucasians.

The most common form is open-angle glaucoma, which has virtually no symptoms. There is no pain associated with the increased eye pressure.
